

Dr. David Whitney, KARA Agronomy Scholarship

BACKGROUND: After more than 30 years of service, Dr. David Whitney retired from the Department of Agronomy at Kansas State University. That includes years of service to the Kansas Agribusiness Retailers Association. KARA is a voluntary professional association for those involved in the plant nutrient and crop protection industry in Kansas. KARA represents more than 700 members' interests in legislative matters at all levels of government, and provides educational opportunities and business services. Dr. Whitney has played an invaluable role in KARA since its early days through Extension activities.

For that reason, the KARA board of directors has established a scholarship in Dr. Whitney's honor. The \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded on an annual basis to undergraduate agronomy students at Kansas State University with preference given to juniors and seniors.
